ESTIMATED PRICE 40 PAYING: \$ 2,800.00 per person, based on a minimum of 40 paying. Persons who don't have American passports, need to apply for visa to Poland. They will need to add the estimated Schengen visa fee of 60.00 EUR per person. PRICING VALID: Prices are an estimate only and subject to change based on actual dollar- zloty exchange rate and airfare during the trip period.

What is included in price?

The following travel, accommodations, meals (breakfast and dinner) and services are included in the price:

Round trip airfare the USA to/from Poland. We included a budget of \$1,000.00 per person. The price is subject to increase based on final airfare costs. The Organization is responsible to increase in airfare costs.

- Thirteen (13) nights of twin room accommodations, including all taxes and service charges.
- Two meals (breakfast at hotel and dinner) per day as per the itinerary
- Local tour guides
- Deluxe air-conditioned bus coach transportation
- Comprehensive sightseeing program and entry tickets

Itinerary subject to change. Venues are tentative and may be replaced with alternatives Itinerary dated 6/13/17

Items that are not included in price:

The following travel, accommodations, meals and services are not included in the price and must be paid separately in full by individual members of the touring party:

- Optional travel and health insurance. Passengers are advised to purchase insurance to cover trip cancelations/interruption, baggage and accident coverage.
- Personal items. Items of a personal nature such as: laundry and telephone calls are not included in the contract price
- Meals not included in final itinerary, including meals at airports and on flights, snacks and water during a trip in Poland.
- Airport and airline meals and snacks. If airlines do not offer complimentary meals, snacks, and/or beverages, the individual is responsible for the cost of purchased meals, snacks, or beverages.
- Cost of obtaining a passport. The passport should be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the period of stay. The Polish Mission is not responsible for ensuring that the travelers comply with

the entry and exit requirements of each destination country and is not responsible for lost, stolen, or unattained passports.

- Cost of obtaining a visa for non US citizens. The current cost is approximately 60.00 EUR per person and is subject to change.

To make reservation, please complete the form and submit it. Additionally, please pay deposit of \$500 per person till September 1, 2017. All checks should be made to The Polish Mission with a note in lower left corner: Trip to Poland.
